REX CORRECTS QANTAS PUNCTUALITY CLAIMS

Rex today calls out Qantas on its persistent claims about being the most on-time domestic airline each month since last September.

In fact, according to the Government's Bureau of Infrastructure and Transport Research Economics (BITRE), Rex's on time departure was 75% in September while Qantas' was only 65%. In four of the last eight months, more Rex flights departed on time than any other airline, according to BITRE figures.

Rex is ranked No.1 in FY22-23 year-to-date for on-time departures while also having the lowest cancellation rate.

"The figures speak for themselves," Rex's Deputy Chairman, the Hon John Sharp, AM, said.

"Rex has a proud history of On-Time-Performance over the last 18 years, a record which stands the test of time and as a publicly-listed company, we are compelled to set the record straight whenever falsehoods are published about our company."

Rex is Australia's largest independent regional and domestic airline operating a fleet of 61 Saab 340 and 7 Boeing 737-800NG aircraft to 58 destinations throughout all states in Australia. In addition to the airline Rex, the Rex Group comprises wholly owned subsidiaries Pel-Air Aviation (air freight, aeromedical and charter operator), the Australian Airline Pilot Academy with campuses in Wagga Wagga and Ballarat, and propeller maintenance organisation, Australian Aerospace Propeller Maintenance. Rex is also a 50% shareholder of National Jet Express (NJE), a premier Fly-In-Fly-Out (FIFO), charter and freight operator.
