## **Rex lifts fuel surcharge**

Regional Express (Rex) lifted its fuel surcharge by \$4 on Wednesday to \$44 per sector.

Rex general manager, network strategy and sales, Warrick Lodge said with the price hitting US\$140 per barrel the company had to ensure partial cost recovery.
