Rex lifts fuel surcharge

The airline is increasing its fuel surcharge from \$30 to \$33 to offset rising petrol prices.

Rex's Dubbo-based airline, Air Link, will also be hit with the price rises.

General manager of corporate services at Rex, Irwin Tan, said the increase was needed because petrol prices were now 15 per cent higher than the last time fares went up.

The last fuel surcharge increase was on March 7 when the surcharge was increased by three dollars, also because of a petrol price jump.

The price rises will take effect tomorrow, with fares from Wagga to Sydney starting at \$115 and fares from Wagga to Melbourne starting at \$125.
