Regional Express Holdings Limited is an Australian company which listed on the Australian Stock Exchange in November 2005. It comprises Regional Express Pty Limited which operates the regional airline Regional Express or "Rex" and the wholly owned subsidiary airline Air Link based in Dubbo, New South Wales. Regional Express Freight and Charter Pty Limited wholly owns the air freight and charter operation Pel – Air Aviation Pty Limited and Rex Investments Holdings Pty Limited is the investment arm of the Group.

Rex commenced operations in August 2002 and is the amalgamation of the two successful regional airlines Hazelton and Kendell which were part of the Ansett Group. Both airlines had a long history of providing quality regional air services throughout New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia and Tasmania. Rex has built on this legacy to become the largest independent regional airline in Australia.

Melbourne: Rex check-in is located on the 1st floor of the Terminal 3 and all Rex flights depart from Gate 14.
